Rules & Regulation

- Application has to be recommended by president/secretary of TPF/Sabha/Mahila Mandal/TYP.
- All applicants would have to provide complete information as given in the application form as well as asked in the personal interview. Any
 wrong information provided or discovered subsequently as incorrect would make the candidature for scholarship null and void IPSO
 FACTO.
- 3. TPF would validate all applications for scholarship through a duly constituted board which would have the right to decide modus operandi for selection.
- 4. All decisions of the said board are final and not subject to any questioning or debate. Any and all scholarships granted are at the complete discretion of the board.
- 5. Applicants to graduate programs are required to have minimum 70% marks in class 10 and 60% in class 12 exams. Students getting below 70% can apply but they would be considered only if there are unutilised seats from the scholarship quota.
- 6. Applicants to post graduate programs are required to have minimum 60% marks in class 12 and atleast 60% marks in graduation. Students getting below this can apply but they would be considered only if there are unutilised seats from the scholarship quota and if the TPF board so deems fit.
- 7. Students who have given board or graduation exams in 2019 but haven't received results yet can also apply. Their applications would be duly considered and scholarship granted once the results are declared and provided they meet all other criterion of selection as per TPF board.
- 8. Every application should be accompanied by a 2 page (atleast 1000 words) statement of purpose written by the applicant himself by his own hand (typed letter not acceptable). Please refer the TPF website for details on write a Statement of Purpose.
- 9. Every candidate desirous of applying for scholarship would have to compulsorily sit for a psychometric assessment test. The said test would be held in most metro cities and many smaller towns of India by TPF through all India career counselling camps starting from March 2019 onwards. The exact dates and venue for the camps can be seen from the TPF website as well as through various releases in the print media.
- 10. Every candidate desirous of applying for scholarship would have to compulsorily sit for a personal interview round. For details on how to handle a personal interview please refer the TPF website. The said Personal Interview process would be held in most metro cities and many smaller towns of India by TPF starting from March 2019 onwards. The exact dates and venue for the camps can be seen from the TPF website as well as through various releases in the print media.
- 11. Some of the participating academic institutions whose seats are being provided by TPF through scholarship may hold their own final selection test process as per their own or university rules. The grant of scholarship will only be complete once the student passes the said eligibility test or criterion of the institute. The student who has been sanctioned scholarship through TPF must keep in touch with the TPF education secretariat as well as the college authorities for details of the said process.
- 12. The 100% scholarship scheme covers the full tuition fees of college for the entire duration of the course for which student is selected. The student has to arrange University fees/Exam fees/Hotel & Revenue Expenses by its own.
- 13. All scholarship applications would have to be accompanied by the following documents as below:
 - 13-1. Age proof
 - 13-2. Address proof (of the parents if not available of the student)
 - 13-3. Parents Income Proof
 - 13-4. Copies of all mark sheets starting from class 10 onwards
 - 13-5. Copies of all awards and achievements received by the student
 - 13-6. Copy of career test report (as conducted by TPF)
 - 13-7. 2 passport sized photo of the student
 - 13-8. 1 postcard sized family photograph
 - 13-9. 2 page Statement of Purpose (to be written in plain A4 page)
 - 13-10. Recommendation letters (from teacher/principal/professor) (this is optional document)
 - 13-11. Duly filled up and signed scholarship application of TPF (can be downloaded from the site)
- 14. The above set can be submitted to authorised officer of TPF at authorised centres (list on the TPF site) upon which a candidate application number with reciept will be provided to the student. The student can keep checking his application status from the TPF site.
- 15. The final date for submission of entries is 30th June 2019.
- 16. The final list of selected students will be released by 15th July 2019.
